- Establishing and maintaining safe systems of work for all operations.
- Routinely reviewing work practices to enhance health and safety performance.
- Ensuring all employees are competent in their roles through proper training and providing clear information on potential workplace risks and hazards.
- Supervising staff until they are fully trained and deemed competent to work independently.
- Avoiding assignment of tasks that could pose health or safety risks to individuals based on age, gender, or medical condition.
- Effectively controlling health and safety risks arising from work activities.
- Conducting annual medical examinations for employees concerning occupational health and safety.
- Preventing work-related accidents and occupational illnesses through proactive risk management.
- Investigating all accidents and incidents thoroughly and implementing corrective actions to prevent recurrence.

- Setting measurable and realistic health and safety targets to track and improve performance.
- Reviewing and updating this policy periodically to reflect current best practices and regulatory requirements.
